Introduction

- Agriculture is one of the most critical sectors of the Indian economy that not only drives the growth and development of agriculture and allied sectors directly but also affects the well-being of rural people at large, their prosperity and employment and also forms an important resource base for a number of agro-based industries and agro-services.
- □ To double farmers' income by 2022, it entails an urgent need for putting in place better farmer-market linkages through developing and upgrading Gramin Haats as Gramin Agricultural Markets (GrAMs) and declaring warehouses/cold storages as market sub-yards.

Eligibility Criteria

1) Every organization is eligible

2) Eligible Project:

Each Project providing direct service to farmers in post harvest management or marketing of their produce. Only primary processing to the farm produce is covered under the scheme. Primary processing means which only adds value to the farm produce but **does not alter the form**

Core Conditions

- ✓ Project must be appraised by eligible financial institutions
- ✓ Storage infrastructure projects should be outside the limits of Municipal corporation areas except in cases where these are situated within Food parks, Market Yards / APMCs, Industrial areas established or approved by State or Central agencies etc
- ✓ Minimum **50% of Project Cost should be raised as term loan** (including subsidy) from eligible financial institutions
- ✓ Minimum **promoter contribution should be 20%** of the project cost.
- ✓ Repayment schedule of **Term Loan should not be less than 5 years**
- Project should be **complete within 18 Months from the date of first disbursement of Term Loan**. If project **completion delayed extended of 6 months with reduction in rate of subsidy @0.5%** for delay of each month or Part thereof.
- ✓ It will be the responsibility of the promoter to have the insurance for the property.
- ✓ **Cost of land not exceeding 10%** (Market value or purchase price whichever is lower) of the **project cost** can form part of the owner's contribution.
- Where plant and machinery is to be installed in civil structure, the cost of **plant & machinery** should be **more than 25% of the Total Financial Outlay (TFO)** of the project. If it is less than 25%, subsidy will be restricted accordingly
- A signboard at the site "Assisted under Integrated Scheme for Agricultural Marketing of Ministry of Agriculture & Farmer Welfare, Government of India" will be exhibited at assisted unit.

- Capacity of 50-5000 MT for all categories of promoters across the country and Capacity of 50-10000 MT for State agencies, in all the States/UTs are eligible for claiming subsidy; however State Agency storage projects, silos up to 15000 MT can be constructed
- To determine the eligibility of projects for maximum permissible subsidy, the date of sanction of loan by FI should be between **22.10.2018** to **31.03.2020**.
